Q1 Define matter?
A1 Anything that occupies space and has mass is known as matter.

Q2 How gases can be liquified?
A2 Applying pressure and reducing temperature can liquify gases.

Q3 Define evaporation?
A3 The phenomenon of change of a liquid into vapours at any temperature below its boiling point is called evaporation.

Q4 Define latent heat of fusion/vaporisation.
A4 Latent heat of fusion: The amount of heat energy that is required to change 1kg of a solid into liquid at atmospheric pressure at its melting point is known as the latent heat of fusion.

Ans 1) Anything that occupies space and has mass is known as matter. No, sunlight is not a matter because it does not occupy space.

Ques 2) Why does the temperature remain constant when a solid starts melting?
Ans 2) When a solid melts and converted into liquid state, the heat energy supplied is used to overcome the force of attraction between particles and hence the temperature remains same.

- 1) Particles of matter have space between them.

Identification & Division Of Work:
